Minimum Qualifications

Experience: One (1) year of full-time, or its equivalent, experience in a health care organization, public health agency or community program performing administrative or program management duties.

Substitution: Possession of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in any of the aforementioned fields and two years of full-time experience in a health care organization, public health agency or community program performing administrative or program management duties may be substituted for the master's degree requirement. One (1) additional year of experience of the type noted above may be substituted for the required academic major. No substitution is permitted for a Bachelor's degree.
