California will <u>sunset its Blueprint for a Safer Economy</u> on June 15, relaxing many of the pandemic health guidelines affecting businesses and community activities – and allowing fully vaccinated people to visit most indoor public places without needing to wear a mask.

Your group or business just needs at least five vaccine-eligible people who want to get vaccinated, but they do not have to live in Contra Costa County, and there is no upper limit to the number of people who can get a vaccine.

Use the convenient <u>online form</u> to request a visit. CCHS will work with you to schedule a time Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m., within one week of your request.
