Very Low Risk

Celebrate virtually with family and friends

LOW RISK

Small outdoor gathering with all vaccinated attendees

MEDIUM RISK

Small indoor gathering where everyone is wearing masks, except when eating and drinking, windows are open to circulate air

HIGH RISK

Large outdoor or indoor gathering with a mix of vaccinated and unvaccinated attendees, no social distancing, eating and drinking occurs, no one is wearing face coverings



Safety Checklist:

- ☐ Get Vaccinated
- Hand Sanitizer
- If feeling sick, stay home and get tested
- List of attendees for potential contact tracing
- ☐ Single use hand towels
- Socially distant games (ex: trivia, scavenger hunt)
- ☐ Face Coverings
- Disposable tableware

MASK USE

- DO wash cloth masks after each use.
- DO make sure to wear a mask that completely covers the nose.
- DO NOT touch the nose, mouth, or eyes when removing masks.
- DO NOT remove mask where there are people within 6 feet.
- DO NOT share masks!





- **10** DO have single use utensils.
- DO have disinfectant wipes and clean everything people touch.
- DO wear mask while serving your own food.
- DO NOT eat from other's plate, drinks, or utensils.
